

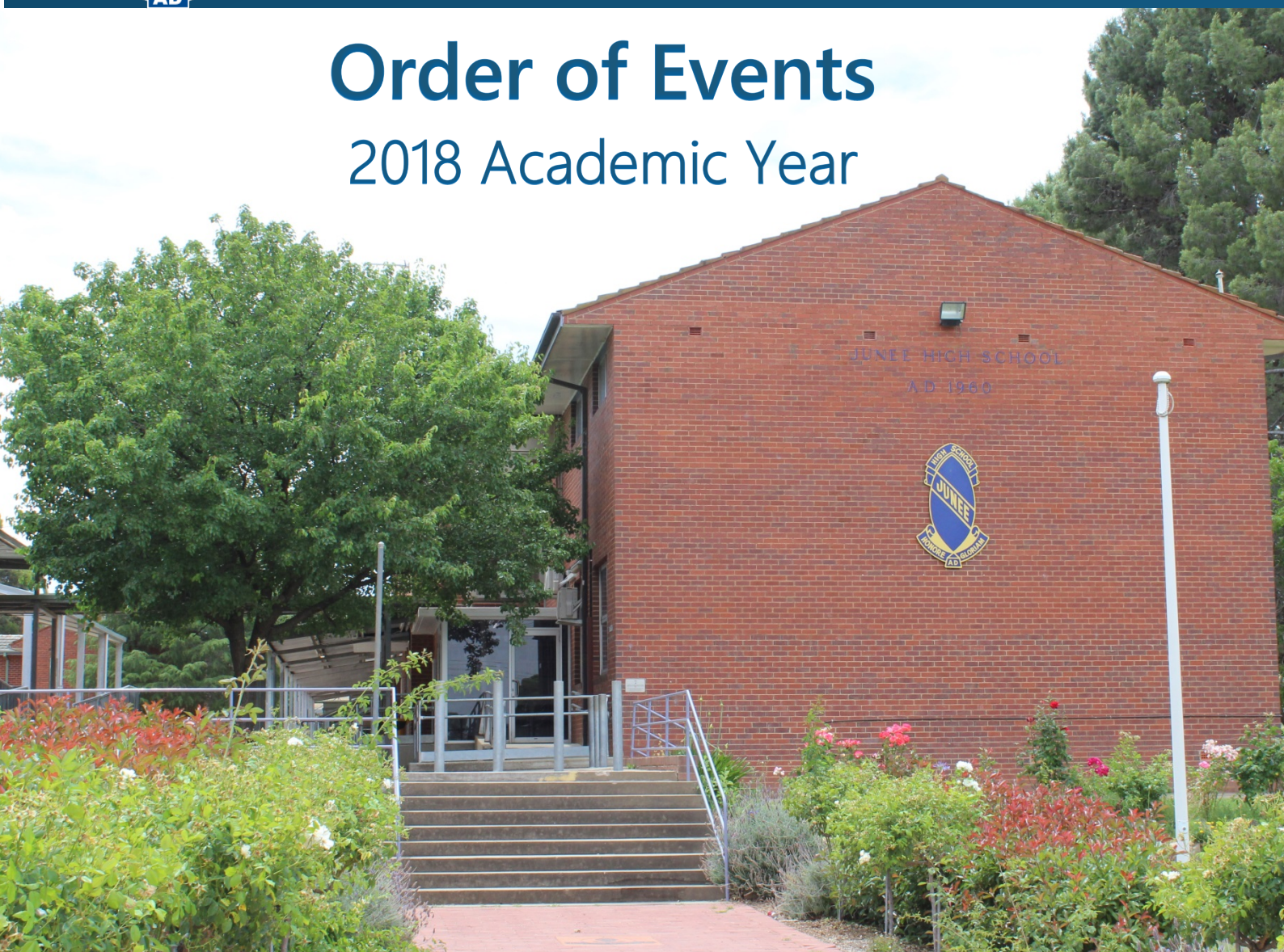

## Principal's Report

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I would like to acknowledge the traditional owners of the land, the people of the Wiradjuri nation, and pay my respects to Aboriginal people past, present and future. We recognise that learning has occurred here for thousands of years and continues to this day.

Thank you for being here to celebrate with us as we recognise the achievements of our students.

Thank you also to Mr Murray Norman who was able to return to our school and let us know of his journey.

Like every year at a school, this year has seen much change, activity and learning. Some in the classroom, some in the playground, on the fields and courts, or in the agriculture area and workshops. Lots of learning and thinking at home, on excursions, on the journeys to and from school. Learning, in a plethora of areas.

At Junee HS, we have provided these areas and opportunities. Our students have been fantastic representing our school, taking the opportunities given to them. Events included an incredible musical and dance production, great sport carnivals, excursions to the beach and to the snow, AgVision 2018, RYDA for Year 11 students, visits to Charles Sturt University, Wollongong University and Canberra University, Western Plains Zoo, Premier's Sporting Challenge days, Year 7 Camp, Project Rockit about keeping safe online, as well as leaders visiting NSW Parliament house and participating in a broadcast of Q&A. Students have seen a forensic science feature in this MPC as well as participating in staff vs Students games. Stage 4 idol with great performances, They have assisted at catering events for Junee residents, Christmas on Broadway, ANZAC day and Remembrance Day services, a Day on the Green afternoon, featuring student and staff bands and the Metal Art Auction and movie night fundraisers. Students have feasted at the GEO Big Brekky each term and raised their awareness of teenage issues through Motivational Media and our link with Junee's You Matter Day. The recent cultural day, with the opening of our yarning circle allowed students to experience a smoking ceremony, being welcomed onto Wiradjuri country by Peter Ingram. Students then enjoyed a number of activities, connecting to country. A small number of students have studied their courses through Aurora College, distance education or combined their learning with TAFE courses, including eight students with a School based traineeship.

Across the school, we have seen improvements with a new colour bond roof for A block, additional seating and signage across the school. We installed over \$110,000 or upgrades of technology across the school with 70 laptops and 20 data projectors and whiteboards. Our Empower Energy project not only developed special skills in the students, but also connected us to our community like no other way could. This then morphed into our R&R group, with reducing energy consumption and recycling making a difference across the school. Some rooms had the blower door technology recommend improvements to our seals, and our team made the improvements. Our R&R team wanted more recycling stations, so we acquired bins for FOGO and bottle recycling with more to come next year.

Congratulations all for the opportunities presented and taken up by students.

On behalf of students and staff, I thank our dedicated P&C. This supportive group meets to work on strategies and activities to support students and I thank them for their efforts. I thank them on your behalf as funds raised contribute to covering transport costs for students representing the school, including sporting, cultural, and leadership activities. Tonight we will also draw the raffle, which has run throughout term 4 – best wishes all!

Thank you also to all the volunteers that help, donating time, money, energy. The staff, the students and I appreciate this. Our school is a part of the Junee Community and I thank the organisations of Junee Shire Council, Lions Club, Rotary Club, View Club, Junee Business & Trades, GEO Group Australia, Men's Shed, Illabo Motor Sports, local businesses and community members. The generosity, contribution, support and care for our school is important and very much appreciated. The opportunities local businesses give our students in work experience, work placement as well as School-based apprenticeships and traineeships is valuable and appreciated, not only by students, but the school and the families.

Thank you parents and community members for supporting our school, working with us on this journey of teenagers and learning.

Each year at our school, as you see and have heard, sees a plethora of activities occur. Please join with me in thanking the wonderful people of this school, helping us all in our journey. Our Executive leaders, teachers, Year Advisors, Learning Support Officers and School Administration staff.

Can I also get you to thank all for their hard work in putting this event together today, especially Emma Turvey, Elaine Bunyan, Tash Harpley, our Year Advisors and our staff for recognising students. Thank you also to the students involved in the setup of sound for this event.

In closing, I thank you again for being here tonight to help us celebrate our 2018 achievements.
