Introduction

The Riverina Regional Plan for the next three years has been developed in consultation with stakeholder groups to ensure a strategic approach to continued school improvement and student achievement remains the focus of the work of all schools supported by the regional officers.

The 2009-2011 regional plan focussed on "raising the bar" and "closing the gap", with professional development of principals, executive and classroom teachers targeted at understanding the *NSW Quality Teaching* model and its implementation, underpinned by strategic use of student achievement data to shape teaching and learning programs. This was undertaken in the context of a greater scrutiny of student achievement through state and federal testing and reporting processes, against state, regional and school student achievement targets. As a result, Riverina public schools operate in a context of a high level of responsibility and accountability to which school leaders have responded with outstanding professionalism and commitment.

The 2012-14 regional plan seeks to build on the schools' achievements by responding to both international research regarding "best practice" schools and systems in student achievement and principal and teacher feedback on local needs. Building on the success of our students requires the further development of their understanding of how they learn, why they learn and what they learn. Consequently, all priority areas of the plan will be underpinned by a regional professional learning project

focussed on these issues – the Riverina Region learning strategy, *HOW2Learn*.

The Riverina regional plan is also predicated on the region's three statements of purpose:

- Students are our core business.
- Riverina Region is committed to supporting school communities in linking learning to student futures.
- We build enabling relationships with schools, communities and agencies to optimise student learning.

The plan outlines the priority areas of school support, the strategies to effect the desired outcomes of the priority areas and the indicators of progress and achievement. The plan will assist schools in identifying areas of regional focus and activity that will support schools with the implementation of their own student-centred context-specific school plans.

School Education Directors will liaise closely with principals on the development, implementation and evaluation of school plans throughout the 2012-14 period. This will assist with the ongoing evaluation of the regional plan's currency in meeting the needs of students in the Riverina public schools.

Affirmation of Regional Purpose

Students are our core business.

Riverina Region is committed to supporting school communities in **linking learning to student futures.** We build **enabling relationships** with schools, communities and agencies to optimise student learning.

Regional Context

The Riverina Region stretches from the mountains to the plains. Regional personnel provide support to 190 schools: 138 primary schools, One infants' school, 26 high schools, 16 central schools, 8 schools for specific purposes and one environmental education centre. These are divided into seven school education groups (SEGs) – Riverina Central, Riverina East, Riverina North, Riverina North West, Riverina South, Riverina South West and Riverina West.

In 2011 the student population was 32 505. There were 16 566 boys and 15 939 girls. Of these students:

- 2196 were enrolled in central schools;
- 238 were enrolled in schools for specific purposes;
- 545 were enrolled in support classes;
- 2765 indigenous students were enrolled;
- 2012 students from a Language Background Other Than English (LBOTE) were enrolled.

The intended outcomes will be achieved through strategic planning and implementation under ten regional portfolios:

- Curriculum Years 9 to 12 including Vocational and Educational Training

Criteria for setting targets for All students

Targets have been set using a 'compounding' approach. The targets for 2012 have been used to calculate the 2013 targets and the targets for 2013 have been used to calculate the 2014 targets. State and regional targets have not been set for the Priority Schools Program (PSP).

At or above the minimum standard targets have been based on reducing the proportion of students below the minimum standard by 2.5% each year in Year 3 and Year 5, and by 1.5% each year in Year 7 and Year 9.

At or below the minimum standard targets have been based on reducing the proportion of students at or below the minimum standard by 2.5% each year in Year 3 and Year 5, and by 1.5% each year in Year 7 and Year 9.

Proficiency standard targets have been based on increasing the proportion of students achieving the proficiency standard by 1.5% each year.

The regional targets are the minimum required to ensure that the state targets are achieved.

Criteria for setting targets for Aboriginal students

The At or above the minimum standard targets for Aboriginal students in NSW DEC are set in accordance with the MCEECDYA requirement for NSW schools to reduce the 2008 gap between Aboriginal students and non-Aboriginal students by 52% by 2018, the reduction to follow a quadratic trajectory.

At or below the minimum standard and Proficiency targets for Aboriginal students are set according to the same criteria as those for All students.

Regional Targets

- Increase percentage of students in proficiency levels in participating HOW2Learn and 2LS schools by 10% after two years.
- Decrease percentage of students identified as having a 'high need' for literacy intervention at the end of the first year of school, using Best Start and Reading Recovery data in L3 targeted schools.
- Student attendance will increase by 1% per annum from 2012 to 2014.
- Long and short suspensions will decrease by 1% per annum from 2012 to 2014
- 100% of new scheme teachers will undertake training around best practice in curriculum delivery for vulnerable students.
